

Tai Sai is a feature game at Christchurch Casino which originates from an ancient Chinese game.

Three dice are utilised and betting options are based on the possible results of the dice. Tai Sai is also referred to as 'Sic Bo'.

HOW TO PLAY

To get started, place any cash on the table and the Dealer will exchange it for gaming chips.

Player's place their bets on what they think will show face up on each of the dice and/or the combinations when they come to rest. When all bets have been placed, the Dealer will call "no more bets". Once the result of the dice is known the winning combinations are illuminated on the table layout, making it easier for Players to see which bets are successful. Winning bets are paid at the displayed odds.

BETS & ODDS BET & DESCRIPTION

Big and Small

Pays 1 to 1

This is a bet that the total of the three dice will either be small (4 – 10) or big (11 – 17). All Big and Small bets lose if a triple appears.

Single Die Result

1 Die pays 1 to 1 2 Die pays 2 to 1

PAYOUT ODDS

3 Die pays 12 to 1

This is a bet on what any of the three dice are going to be. If one of the dice comes up with your number, you win and if two or three dice come up with the same number you win even more.

Pays 6 to 1

Two Dice Combination

This is a bet on what any two of the three dice will be. If the combination that you select comes in, you win.

Three Dice Totals

Totals pay 6 to 1 or more up to 62 to 1

This is a bet on the total of the 3 dice. To check the odds for your favourite numbers, just look on the table.

Specific Doubles

This is a bet that at least two of the three dice are going to be the same - a double.

If you select a double that comes up, you win.

Any Triple

Pays 31 to 1

Pays 11 to 1

This is a bet that all 3 dice will show the same number – a triple. With this bet you don't have to pick what the numbers will be, as long as they are all the same.

Specific Triple

Pays 180 to 1

This is a bet that all 3 dice will show the same number - a triple. You need to select the specific numbers to win.
